Format of tournament:

- Maximum of 4 teams per division, EACH TEAM IS GUARANTEED 4 GAMES
- Players can only register & play in one division In the Tournament .
- All players must participate regularly in their House League schedule in conjunction with their Select program
- Round Robin tournament structure 1st and 2nd place teams play the 4th game for the championship, 3rd and 4th place teams play the 4th game for the consolation
- Tournament open to GTHL/NYHL Select teams, Mississauga and Oakville "Red ", Brampton Intercity and others...

- You must provide an Approved signed/ stamped league roster from your Organization tp participate.

TOURNAMENT RULES /FORMAT

Periods

1st & 2nd 12 minutes, 3rd 15 minute periods running time with the last minute of the 3rd period, stop time. Time outs (1 minute) Dec.30th & 31st (Championship and Consolation games). One for each team. No time outs in Round Robin play.

Body Checking

There will be no body checking for all divisions.

Point System

Points are to awarded as follows (maximum of 5 points per game)

Game Win - 2 pointsGame Tie - 1 pointPeriod Win - 1 pointPeriod Tie - ½ point(For example: If a team wins by a score of 3-0 and scores a goal in each of the 3 periods, the team will be awarded 5 points)

Tie Breakers

Tie breakers for teams tied in points after the 3rd game will be decided in the following order:

- 1. winner of head to head games
- 2. most wins
- 3. fewest losses
- 4. best goals differential (difference between goals for and goals against)
- 5. most goals scored
- 6. fewest goals allowed
- 7. most goals scored in game 3
- 8. most goals scored in game 2
- 9. most goals scored in game 1

Overtime

No overtime for round robin games. If tied, at end of regular play of the fourth game; a five minute sudden death overtime will take place, with running time and line changes on the fly. Format will be 4 on 4.

If the game is still tied after the 5-minute overtime, a shootout will break the tie:

- each team is to pick three players to participate in the shootout
- toss of a coin will decide which team goes first, then teams alternate, (Home Team to call the toss)
- the team with the most goals wins, after each team shoots three times
- if still a tie, the shootout continues as sudden death, each team picking a new player excluding the three picked previously, until a team wins. You must use all players on bench before using a player previously chosen.

Championship and Consolation Round

The first and second place teams within each division will play the fourth game for the Gold Medal Championship. The third and fourth place teams within each division will play the fourth game for the Bronze Medal.

Penalties

Minor penalty will be 2 minutes running time. Major penalty will be 5 minutes running time. All penalties will be in accordance with OHF & GTHL rules. Expulsion from tournament for any fighting major. A full set of Tournament Rules will be available for team staff.
